ORAL ORDER

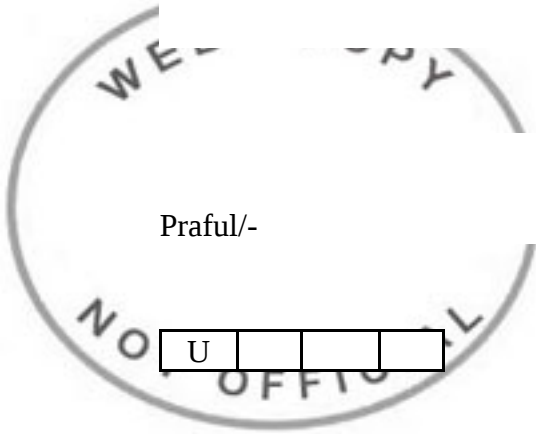
