The engagement of the petitioner was in terms of an agreement entered between the petitioner and the respondent State Health Society, Bihar. The said agreement is Annexure-3.

If the petitioner wants to file an application before the authority under Clause 12 of the said agreement for settlement of the dispute between the parties, well and good, otherwise, petitioner always has remedy available under common law.

This Court is not willing to issue a mandamus to continue

with a contract and relationship when there is complete breakdown of trust between the parties and allegations and counter allegations have been made which are rather unsavory. The organization cannot function in the above situation.

Writ application is dismissed with above liberty.
