ORAL ORDER

02 09-06-2015 The petitioner, who is the husband, apprehends his arrest
in Charpokhari P.S. Case No.62 of 2015 instituted under Section-
498 A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner brings to the notice of
this Court that the marriage was solemnized about 10 years back.
There are two children of 8 years and 6 years old. The wife has
walked out from the house because she refuses to look after his
old parents and take their responsibility. As per the F.I.R., she had
left the house two years back. She is only creating a ground to
claim other benefits without discharging her social obligation as a

wife.

Be that as it may, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, the petitioner, namely, Mantu Kumar Rai, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Charpokhari P.S. Case No.62 of 2015, subject to all conditions as laid down in Section-438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
