2 28-04-2015 This application under Section 482 of the Code of
Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of the order dated
17.01.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. Case No. 808 of 2014 by the Sub-
divisional Magistrate, Hilsa in a proceeding under Section 144 of
the Code of Criminal Procedure.

In my view, the application is misconceived as no order
passed under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure shall
remain in force for more than two months from the making
thereof. The impugned order in the present case has been filed on
17th Jan, 2015. It has lost all its force after expiry of two months

on 17.03.2015.
