This appeal is preferred by Ramesh Kurmi, who figured
as accused No. 3 in Sessions Trial No. 119 of 1987 on the file of
learned IIInd Additional Sessions Judge, Bettiah. Through its
judgment dated 09.10.1991 the trial Court convicted the
accused along with other three accused for committing the
murder of one Raj Kumar Mahto on 30.08.1984.

When the matter was listed for hearing on 07.08.2014
this Court called for a report from the Juvenile Justice Board,

West Champaran at Bettiah for determination of the age of the appellant and other three accused. After verification of the matter, the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, West Champaran, Bettiah has submitted his report dated 30th January, 2015 to the effect that Ramesh Kurmi, the appellant herein died on 27.11.2008.

Therefore, this appeal is dismissed as abated.
