3 04-09-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
instituted under Section 498(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is of torturing the
informant for non fulfillment of demand of additional dowry.

On behalf of the petitioner, it has been submitted that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. He is ready to keep the
informant as his wife with full dignity and honour. It is also
submitted that the petitioner is ready to deposit an amount of Rs.
2000/- (two thousand) per month in the court below, which may
be released in favour of the informant.

Considering the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is directed

to deposit an amount of Rs. 2000/- (two thousand) per month in the court below, which shall be released in favour of the informant.

Let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Smt. Rashmi Prasad, learned J.M., 1st class in connection with Beur P.S.Case No.249/2013, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C.
