flour mill premises and raised a punitive bill of Rs.1, 86,397/-

alleging energy theft, by tampering the meter. Gardanibagh

Police station Case No. 54 of 2013 was also lodged under

section 135 of the Electricity Act in this respect.

In the facts of the case, the petitioner should file his

objection before respondent no.4 under section 126 of the

Electricity Act, who would dispose of the same in accordance

with law, after providing a copy of the provisional assessment,
if already not served to the petitioner.
