2 22-04-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the

State.

The petitioners being the brother's wife and nephew of
the husband of the daughter of the informant are apprehending
arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under
Section 304B of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the daughter of the
informant within 5 years of marriage for non-fulfillment of
dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners
that the victim died due to accidental burn injury. The husband of
petitioner no.1 also received injury while rescuing the victim.
The victim was given medical assistance and the petitioners
claim to be separate from the family members of the victim.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad (Bihar) in connection with Kasma P.S. Case No.23 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
