Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the point raised in this writ petition is covered by judgment dated 16.04.2015 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 8227 of 1994 which arose out of order dated 05.08.1994 passed in Revenue Appeal No. 11/1992-93 by District Collector, East Champaran, Motihari. In the present writ case order dated 05.08.1994 passed by the same District Collector in Revenue Appeal No. 15/92-93, Annexure-3 is the subject matter.

2. This writ petition is also disposed of

exactly in the same terms contained in judgment dated 16.04.2015 passed in C.W.J.C.
