The writ petition has been filed for a direction to the
respondent authorities to conclude the proceedings pending before
the Sub-Divisional Magistrate (Sadar), Begusarai arising from
Section 145 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The petitioner complains intrusion by the private
respondents over his shopping complex.

A counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of the
respondent nos. 3 and 4 enclosing the order passed by the Sub-
Divisional Magistrate, Begusarai in the proceedings initiated

under Section 145 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and with reference thereto, it is submitted that by order passed on 4.3.2014 the proceedings have been dropped and thus the writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
