ORAL ORDER

2 30-04-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the

State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341/323/324/307/379/504/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that accused persons assaulted the informant, informant's sons, father and other relative and also took away Rs.1200/- and a watch from the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the injury report suggest that the informant received no injury and others received simple injury. There is counter version of the occurrence also in which one of the injuries appears to be grievous. A statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan in connection with Daraunda P.S. Case No.262 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
