petitioners apprehend their arrest in relation to Nirmali P.S. Case

No. 53 of 2015 registered under Sections 464/34 of the Indian

Penal Code and Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act for

the allegation that the domestic cylinders were found being kept

unauthorizedly by petitioner Shambhu Kumar Ray alias Shambhu Ray having been purchased from the dealer petitioner Anjana Verma.

Having heard Mr. N.K. Agrawal, learned senior counsel in support of the anticipatory bail applications, in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within four weeks from today, let the petitioners, namely, Shambhu Kumar Ray alias Shambhu Ray and Anjana Verma be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Supaul in connection with Nirmali P.S. Case No. 53 of 2015, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
