The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Dhanarua P.S. Case No. 59 of 2014 registered for the
offence under Section-414 of the Indian Penal Code.

One stolen motorcycle is said to have been
recovered from the house of the petitioner but stand of the
petitioner is that he had purchased the said motorcycle from one,
Rakesh Kumar and after that, got entered his name in the relevant
documents which is evident from perusal of Annexure-6 to the
supplementary affidavit.
