ORAL ORDER

2 07-05-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
A.P.P. as well as learned counsel for the complainant.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered under Sections 498(A), 307 and other sections of the
Indian Penal Code and Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The petitioner is husband and is ready to keep his
wife.

Considering the willingness of the petitioner to keep
his wife, the above named petitioner is directed to surrender in the
court below within four weeks from today and the court below
shall grant provisional bail to the petitioner on furnishing bail
bond in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two

sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in Hajipur Sadar P.S. Case No. 22 of 2015.

The court below shall also issue notice to the complainant and make all efforts for reconciliation of the dispute between the husband and the wife. If the dispute is resolved amicably between the parties, the provisional bail granted to the petitioner shall be confirmed. In case the dispute is not resolved, the court below shall pass orders on the prayer for provisional bail of the petitioner on its own merit in accordance with law.
