ORAL ORDER

2 13-07-2015 Petitioner being husband of the complainant
is apprehending his arrest in a complaint case wherein
processes were directed to be issued after cognizance being
taken for the offences punishable under Section 498A of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-
fulfilment of dowry demand.

On instructions, it is submitted by learned
counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is ready to keep the
complainant as wife with full dignity and honour.

Considering the present stand of the
petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his
arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12
weeks from today, be released on provisional anticipatory bail

for one year, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Complaint Case No. 2980 of 2014.

Let learned Court below issue notice to the complainant and fix a date for her appearance. On appearance, the petitioner will take the complainant to her matrimonial house to keep her as wife with full dignity and honour.

The provisional anticipatory bail of the petitioner will be confirmed by the learned Court below in three eventualities (i) On substantial restoration of the matrimonial harmony within a period of one year (ii) If the complainant fails to appear before learned Court below (iii) If the complainant is reluctant to reconcile the issue.
