Since, it is not a case of rejection as yet by the University, claim of the petitioners for grant of promotion from the post of Reader to the post of Professor under time bound scheme, it will be advisable for the petitioners to first approach the Vice-Chancellor of Patna University with their claim.

Let, Vice-Chancellor consider the matter in terms of the existent rules and statutes and pass a final order on the claim within a period of three months of filing of such an

application.

It goes without saying that, if the decision is contrary to the interest of the petitioners, they surely have remedy available for them.

Writ is disposed of with the above liberty.
