The writ application has been filed for a direction
commanding upon the respondents not to hold cattle fair (Pashu
Mela) and appoint collection agent for collecting the market fee by
auction on the land of the petitioner which is said to be raiyati
land. A claim in this regard was filed before the LRDC, Jehanabad
which appears to have been rejected by a reasoned order.
