Let the petitioners approach the Director, High
Education, Government of Bihar, Patna with regard to

the grievance raised herein, who will issue appropriate direction to the college concern as to how the distribution of the grant-in-aid is going to be made.

Such a decision of the Director may be made applicable across the board to all such institutions, which receive grant-in-aid to bring about some kind of uniformity and no discrimination is made with the management in disbursal of such grants in favour of the regular employees, validly appointed.

Such a direction must be issued within a period of three months on an application being filed by the petitioners.

Writ application stands disposed off with observation / direction as above.
