Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307, 507 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that on protest being made by the informant for demolishing his newly constructed house, the petitioner assaulted with iron rod on the head of the informant whereas co-accused Bir Bahadur assaulted with rami on the right wrist of the informant and others assaulted with lathi.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the injury on the head of the informant has been found to superficial simple in nature and there is counter version of the occurrence also. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Piro (Hasan Bazar) P.S. Case No. 316 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
