ORAL ORDER

2 22-01-2015 Keeping in mind the various orders, which have been passed from time to time by several Benches of this Court, some of which have been annexed as Annexure-7 and Annexure-7/A., the reason for rejection of the claim of the petitioner for regularization in the Project School becomes vulnerable. The only reason given by the Director, Secondary Education, Government of Bihar is that the petitioner was overage on the date of his appointment. Such matters have already been adjudicated in quite a detail after taking into consideration the several orders and

judgments including the Full Bench decision, reported in 2000(1)P.LJ.R 287.

Annexure-1 in so far as it relates to the present petitioner is quashed. The writ application is allowed.

The Director is directed to pass a fresh order in favour of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of production of a copy of this order.
