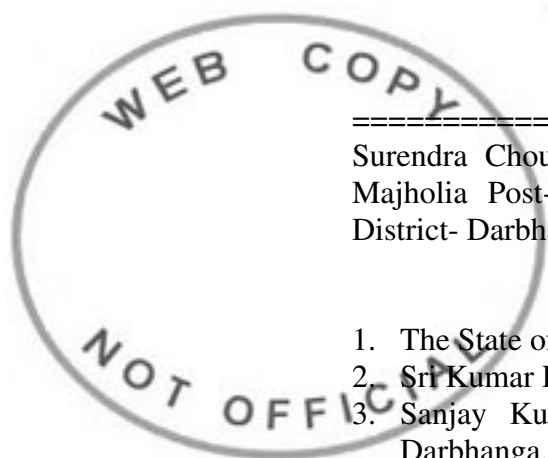

Learned counsel AC to AAG-9 submits that in compliance of the order under contempt, the representation of the petitioner has been disposed of by removing the encroachment on 16.07.2014 in presence of the petitioner himself, which has been detailed in paragraph no.8 of the show cause filed on behalf of the opposite party no.5, Circle Officer, Hayaghat Block, District – Darbhanga.
