Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with
Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No. 236 of 2013 registered for the offence
under Sections-304(B), 201/34of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner No. 1 is elder brother-in-law and
petitioner No. 2 is Gotani of the deceased and contention on behalf
of petitioners is that they are separate from husband of the
deceased, which is evident from perusal of Annexure-2 to this
petition. It is also pointed out that moreover, the statement of the
deceased was recorded in hospital and in the said statement, she
specifically, stated that she was caught in fire, accidentally.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submission of the parties, let the petitioners named above, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of order in the court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No. 236 of 2013 to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan subject to conditions as laid down u/S 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
