ORAL ORDER

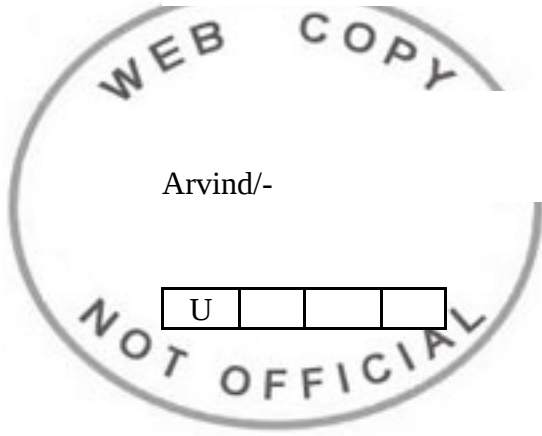
