4 02-11-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State and the informant.

The petitioner, being the mother-in-law, is apprehending her arrest in connection with Aungari P.S. Case No.27 of 2014 for allegedly having committed the offence under Sections 498A, 304B, 201 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Case diary in the present case was called for, which has since been received.

Considering the peculiar nature of allegations and that the mother-in-law has specific role to play in the alleged death of the niece of the informant and the body was

surreptitiously removed without information to the informant and the family members of the deceased, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. It is, accordingly, rejected.
