Submission is that the petitioner was on bail during the course of investigation and the police after investigation submitted charge sheet under bailable Sections of the Indian Penal Code, but the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate took cognizance under Section 302 and other Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the anticipatory bail petition.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

It goes without saying that if once the petitioner is on bail he shall remain on bail even after taking cognizance unless the bail bond of the petitioner is cancelled in accordance with law.
