2 11-08-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Nasriganj P.S. Case No.96 of 2014 for allegedly having committed the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 353 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only because the petitioner belongs to the village where the alleged blockade of the road has been made by the villagers, the petitioner has been named in the present F.I.R.

Considering the nature of the allegations made against the petitioner and also the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents, let the petitioner, above named, in the

event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate (1st Class)-cum-Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bikramganj, Rohtas, in connection with Nasriganj P.S. Case No.96 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
