Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147/148/341/324/325/307/504 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the accused persons came variously armed with and brutally assaulted the informant, his father Peru Yadav and uncle Chhavi Yadav.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that all the three injuries have been found simple in nature. There is counter versions of the occurrence and petitioner's side also received injury. A statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or

surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jamui in connection with Chandramandih P.S. Case No.22 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
