learned counsel for O.P. No.2 as well as the learned counsel

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in
connection with Complaint Case No.1747 of 2014 for allegedly
having committed the offence under Section 498A of the
Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted by the parties that the relationship
between them has now been normalized and they are living
together in peace and harmony. A supplementary affidavit to
the said effect has also been filed today.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Hajipur, in connection with Complaint Case No.1747 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
