The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered under Sections 406, 409, 418, 420, 467 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is alleged to have defalcated Rs. 2,09,769/- from the funds of Mid-Day-Meal.

It is submitted that the petitioner has already deposited the entire amount in the SBI A/C No. 30369755369 of Mid-Day-Meal. To this effect, letter no. 73 dated 30.01.2015 was sent by the Block Education Extension Officer (the informant) to the Officer-in-charge informing him that the petitioner has already deposited the entire amount.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named

petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri A.K. Dixit, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Araria in Narpatganj P.S. Case No. 91/2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
