The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection in
connection with Jamhore P.S.Case No. 35/2015 registered for the
alleged offences under Sections 420, 406, 409 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter
is purely civil liabilities and there are various orders of the
Hon'ble Court in support of his said contention. He further
