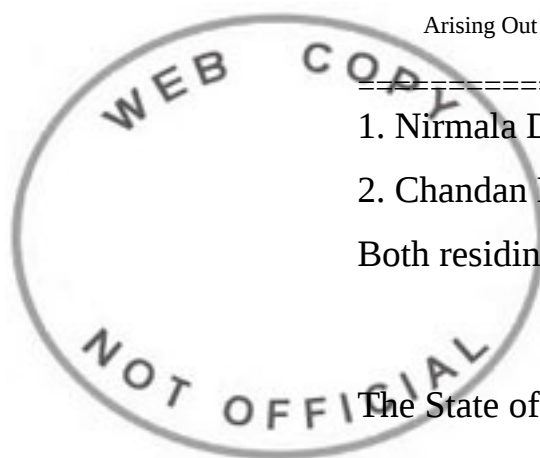

2 10-06-2015 The petitioners apprehend their arrest in relation to L.N.M.U. P.S. Case No. 202 of 2014 instituted under Sections 341, 342, 323, 406, 420, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that informant is land broker and want to trap valuable land of the petitioners by filing criminal cases. In the First Information Report though it is mentioned that there was an agreement to sell, no such document has ever been produced either before the police or along with the First Information Report. It is further submitted that it is case of civil nature being breach of agreement.

Be that as it may, in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within four

weeks, let the petitioner, namely, Nirmala Devi and Chandan Kumar, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga, in connection with L.N.M.U. P.S. Case No. 202 of 2014, subject to conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
