2 04-03-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 47 (a) of the Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is for the first time that the petitioner has been implicated in a case registered under sections 47 (a) of the Bihar Excise Act. He has further submitted that from the prosecution report, it appears that no material has been recovered from the petitioner's possession but recovery was made from the bank of some river.

Considering the facts and circumstances, in case of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks, the above named

petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Sasraram District- Rohtas in connection with Excise Case No. 18/2014, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of Cr. P.C.
