In the instant application filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the prayer of the petitioner is to direct the respondents to arrest one Shri Abhimanyu Kumar @ Mukesh Kumar who is accused in connection with Bhagalpur Kotwali P.S. Case No. 750 of 2008 registered under Sections 409, 419, 420, 422, 423, 467, 468, 471, 474 and 478 of the

Indian Penal Code.

At the outset, learned counsel for the State has submitted that the accused Abhimanyu Kumar @ Mukesh Kumar has already been arrested by the police on 4.9.2014 in Bhagalpur Kotwali P.S. Case No. 750 of 2008.
