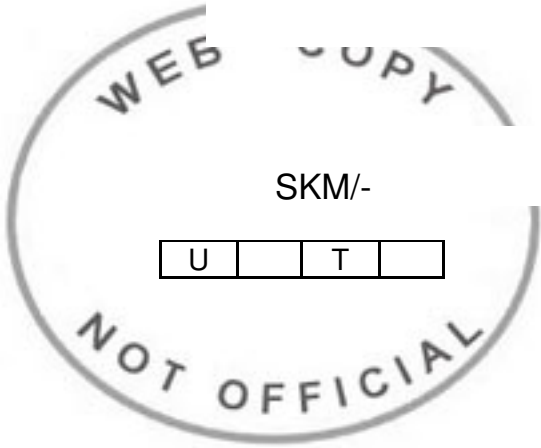
Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Having perused the material and the
circumstances under which the above case has been
instituted against the petitioner, chances of false
implication by a police for a reason cannot be brushed
aside.

In view of the same, anticipatory bail
application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above-named, in the event
of his arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks
from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond
of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the
like amount each to the satisfaction of Railway Judicial
Magistrate, Ara, Bhojpur, in connection with Ara Rail P.
S. Case No. 57 of 2014, which shall be abide by the

terms and conditions mentioned in sub-section (2) of section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
