The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order of non-discharge dated 22.5.2015 passed by the Additional District & Sessions Judge IV, Buxar in Sessions Trial No.54 of 2015 arising out of Brahmpur P.S. case No.287 of 2014.

Having considered the facts of the case, I do not find any merit in the application. The same is dismissed.
