The Petitioners seek quashing of the order of non-discharge dated 11.6.2015 passed by the 4th Additional Sessions Judge, Araria in Sessions Trial No.1363 of 2013 arising out of Complaint case No.3271 of 2008.

Considering that the Petitioners seek discharge on questions of fact which cannot be gone into at the stage of 482 Cr.P.C, I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The application is dismissed.
