Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Prayer for anticipatory bail application of Petitioner No. 1 has become infructuous, as he has already been arrested and enlarged on regular bail.

Looking at the material and the circumstances, under which the above case has been instituted against the petitioner as well as chances of false implication by the police for a reason, which cannot be brushed aside, anticipatory bail application of Petitioner No. 2 is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond

of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur, Arrah, in connection with Ara Rail Police Station Case No. 57 of 2014, which shall be abide by the terms and conditions mentioned in sub-section (2) of section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
