ORAL ORDER

2 30-07-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case instituted under Sections 498(A) and other allied Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he forcibly married with the complainant, established physical relation with her and thereafter ousted her from the house. The accused persons also demanded additional dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that he is ready to keep the complainant as his wife with full dignity and honour. It is also submitted that the petitioner is

ready to deposit an amount of Rs. 1500/- (fifteen hundred) per month in the court below, which shall be released in favour of the complainant.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner is directed to deposit an amount of Rs. 1500/- per month in the court below, which shall be released in favour of the complainant.

Let, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Danapur in connection with Complaint Case No. 1305 (C) of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C.
