The stand of the counsel for the petitioners is that there have been some circulars in the past where extension of age of superannuation for National Award Winners in the category of Teachers is required to be given.

The stand of the respondent Sanskrit Shiksha Board and the State is that whatever had happened had happened in the past now the rules and regulations governing service conditions of such

teachers of Sanskrit schools under the control of Sanskrit Shiksha Board stands codified by virtue of notification no.99 dated 13.2.2015.

The answer lies therein. However, counsel for the petitioner wants a decision to be communicated to the petitioners on their status. With a heavy heart, the Court directs that the Principal Secretary, Education is saddled with the burden for making a communication on such claim of the petitioners keeping the law as it is. Let such a communication be made within a period of 10 weeks from the date of production of a copy of this order.

Writ stands disposed of.
