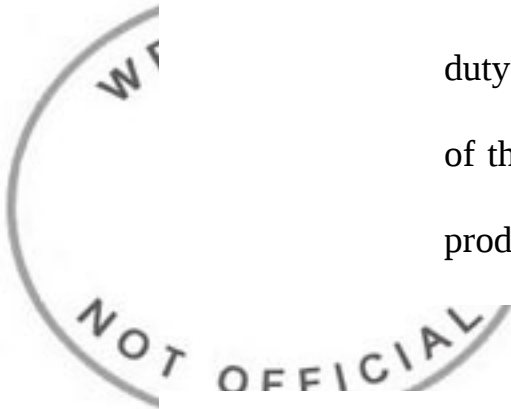

3 03-02-2015 Taking in view the stand taken by the Staff Selection Commission, including the communication made to them in terms of Annexure-A dated 1-9-2009, the previous direction of the Court loses its meaning.
