The writ application has been filed in the nature of PIL,
seeking a direction for removal of encroachment from a land as
described in paragraph-1 of this writ application, as according to
the petitioner, the said land has been recorded as river in Khatiyan.

From the pleadings on record, it appears that the petitioner
is a villager of village Dukhiya and he, too, has his own interest in
the village.

On considering the matter in its entirety, we find that this writ application cannot be entertained in the nature of public interest litigation and, is accordingly, dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to take recourse to appropriate provisions of law, if so advised.
