The Petitioners seek quashing of the order of non-discharge dated 19.2.2014 passed by the Adhoc Additional Sessions Judge 1st, Katihar in S.T. No.414 of 2013 arising out of Azam Nagar P.S. case No.134 of 2009.

The Petitioners seek discharge on questions of fact which cannot be gone into at the stage of 482 Cr.P.C, I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.
