AC to GP No. 21.

The present petition was filed with a prayer to initiate
contempt proceeding against opposite parties on an allegation of

willful disobedience to an order dated 12/4/2012 passed in CWJC No. 19210 of 2011. By the said order termination of the petitioners against work charge establishment was set aside by this court and direction was issued to the respondents to consider the case of regularization and pass a speaking order.

In the present petition petitioners have brought on record Annexure - '3' whereby the opposite party/ Secretary, Road Construction Department has considered the case of regularization and passed a speaking order.

In the supplementary show cause filed on behalf of opposite party no. 4 to 6, a specific statement has been made that in compliance with the order of the writ court, petitioners have already been re-instated as work charge employee on their respective posts.

In view of the fact that in compliance with the order of the writ court petitioners have already been re-instated and a reasoned order on the point of regularization has already been passed vide Annexure - '3', there is no need to keep the matter pending.

The petition stands disposed of.

If petitioners feel aggrieved with Annexure - '3' whereby claim for regularization has been rejected, petitioners

would be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy.
