GP 8 as well as Sri Sarvadeo Singh, learned counsel, who has

appeared on behalf of officials of Vir Kunwar Singh University,

Ara.

In this case, by way of filing show cause the University
has brought on record an order dated 29.11.2014 passed by the
Vice-Chancellor, Vir Kunwar Singh University, whereby the case
of the petitioner was considered and claim of the petitioner has
been rejected assigning detailed reason.

Learned counsel for the University submits that in
compliance with the order of the writ court, a reasoned order has

been passed.

Keeping in view the order passed by the Vice-Chancellor, Vir Kunwar Singh University, Ara there is no need to further proceed with the matter.
