Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated
8.2.2011 by which the Sessions Judge, Muzaffarpur, in Criminal
Revision No. 06 of 2011 has affirmed the order of non-discharge
dated 1.12.2010 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class,
Muzaffarpur, in Kazi Mohammadpur P.S. Case No. 251 of 2004.

Considering that now charges have been framed, I am
not inclined to interfere in the matter, the application stands
dismissed.

The Trial Court is directed to conclude the Trial
expeditiously without granting unnecessary adjournment to any Party
