The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Balrampur
P.S.Case No. 84/2014 instituted for the offences punishable under
sections 341, 323, 354, 379, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution story as alleged in the F.I.R. is that one
Sumitra Devi started assaulting the informant along with other
persons and the petitioner also caught her sari and started pulling
it. The said allegation against the petitioner does not make an
allegation of outraging the modesty of the informant.

Under the said circumstances, it is directed that in the
event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from
today, the above named petitioner, Subhash Sahni, shall be

released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar in connection with Balrampur P. S. Case No. 84/2014, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of Cr. P.C.
