2 02-04-2015 This application has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for providing police protection to the petitioner as he apprehends threat at the hands of respondent no.6 to 11.

In my view threat perception of a citizen can be assessed by the authority of the State and not by this Court. In case, the petitioner has any threat to his life at the hands of the private

respondents, he can approach the District Level Security Committee in this regard. In case such an application is filed before the Committee, it would consider the same and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

With these observations, the application is disposed of.
