ORAL ORDER

2 04-09-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners being the brother, brother's wife and mother of the husband of the daughter of the informant are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A and 328/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of administering poison to the daughter of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the accusation is omnibus and general. The informant's side earlier lodged Complaint Case Nos. 2825 of 2006 and 2976 of 2007 levelling accusation under Section 498A and other provisions of the IPC wherein the petitioners are on bail.

Considering the fact that the thrust of accusation is

against the husband of the daughter of the informant, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Hajipur Town P.S. Case No. 325 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
