4 30-10-2015 Heard Mr. Siya Ram Shahi, learned counsel for the appellants, and Mr. Rajiv Roy, learned GP 5, appearing for the State.

Mr. Siya Ram Shahi, learned counsel for the appellants, fairly submits that the appellants were writ petitioners in C.W.J.C.No. 11065 of 2013 and had filed this letters patent appeal against the dismissal of their writ petition by the order, dated 07.02.2014, passed by the learned single Judge of this Court.

Issuance of a writ of *mandamus* to the respondent No.7, namely, R.N.Mukherjee Ayurvedic College and Hospital, Motihari, directing them to remove their deficiencies, which have been pointed out by the respondent No. 9, namely, Bihar

University, where the appellants, as students, have completed their study

The appellants seek leave to withdraw this appeal with liberty to make appropriate writ petition.
