ORAL ORDER

2 21-08-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners being the parents and co-villagers of the husband of the complainant apprehending arrest in a complaint case wherein process has been directed to be issued after cognizance being taken for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 498A and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-fulfillment of the dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that accusation of torture is omnibus and general and thrust of accusation is against the husband of the complainant.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM, (West) Muzaffarpur in connection with Complaint Case No. 127 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
